Diabetes is a chronic condition that can affect the heart, blood vessels, kidneys, eyes, and nerves. People living with diabetes are at a higher risk for:




- Manage Blood Sugar Better Testing after meals, exercise, and medication helps you understand how your body responds and what adjustments you may need to make.
